'The Fourth Primary Education Development Programme (PEDP-4)' is being implemented during the period July 2018 to June 2025 by the Directorate of Primary Education under Ministry of Primary and Mass Education. Government of Japan has already provided total 1500 Million Yen grant in last three years for the Programme. This grant provided by Japan will be utilized for the Year 4 (four) of the Programme.
