- Minimum time limits for submission of tenders

  - On CPTU website



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# Overview of PPA 2006 and PPR 2008

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## PPA 2006 and PPR 2008



PPA passed by the Parliament in year 2006

# Scope of Application of PPA 2006

#### Act [Section 3 & 4]

- > PPA extends to the whole of Bangladesh
- Overrides other laws: Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law, the provisions of the PPA shall prevail

#### **Exceptions**

➤ Unless the Government otherwise decides in the interest of national security or national defence, public procurement shall be undertaken in accordance with this Act [Section 68(2)]

# Scope of Application of PPA 2006 cont'd

#### Act [Section 3(2)]

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#### PPA shall apply to:

- a) Procurement by PEs using public funds
- b) Procurement by any government, semi-government or any statutory body established under any law
- c) Procurement using public funds by a company registered under the Companies Act (Act No.18, 1994)
- d) Procurement under a loan, credit or grant agreement or under any other agreement with a development partner or with a foreign state or an organisation, provided that if there is anything to the contrary in any such agreement entered into, the provision of that agreement shall prevail

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#### **Procurement Methods**

- ➤ Open Tendering Method <u>preferred</u> method (Section 31):
  - Goods, Works, Physical Services
  - With or without pre-qualification

National & International Competitive Tendering

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# Procurement related documents (Section 12)

Standard Documents (STD, SPD, SRP etc.), Goods, Works, Services, shall be issued by CPTU

**Standard Documents are mandatory** 

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- ➤ Invitation for tenders shall be published (Section 40):
  - In newspapers
  - On PE's own website
  - On CPTU website

No information shall be disclosed prior to publishing

- > Tender documents available (Section 44):
  - Sale
  - Website


- Public tender opening (Section 47)
- Evaluation of tenders in compliance with pre-disclosed criteria (Section 48)
- No negotiations in goods and works except direct procurement as the main rule (Section 49)
- Mandatory negotiations in case of consultancy services (Section 60)

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- Contract award (Section 21-23 & 51-53)
  - Approval of successful tenderer
  - Notification of award to successful tenderer - NOA
  - NOA shall be published
  - Signing of contract
  - Notifying un-successful tenderers
- Records of procurement shall be maintained

# PPR 2008: Chapter wise Contents

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# **PPR – Some Main Rules**

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#### PE will consider:

- Tender validity period
- Tender security, validity period
- Performance security, retention money

#### PPR - Some Main Rules

#### Tender/Proposal Validity

Rule- 19,20,22 and 23

- Validity Period depends on complexity and time needed for Tender/ Proposal evaluation and approval, and shall be within the limits specified in Schedule II (60 to 120 days)
- Shorter or longer periods are authorised by HOPE or AO to suit the requirements of a particular Procurement
- On justifiable grounds in exceptional circumstances, PE may request Tenderers/Applicants to extend the Tender/Proposal Validity Period
- First Extension by HOPE but Second Extension requires approval of next higher authority
- Tenderers/Applicants may refuse to extend its Tender/Proposal Validity

#### Tender Validity is linked to Tender Security

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#### **PPR – Some Main Rules**

# Qualification requirements, eligibility criteria

- Professional, technical and ethical standards
- > Ability to implement the contract
- Legal capacity
- Financial capability and status

# PPR – Some Main Rules Session: F-1 Slide No.19/24

#### **Evaluation of tenders**

- > Tenderers may be asked for clarification
  - No substantial changes are allowed (such as price, delivery schedule)
  - An apparently non-responsive tender cannot be made responsive
- Tenderers may be asked for detailed price breakdown
- Calculating lowest evaluated price
- Evaluation proceedings shall be kept confidential

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## PPR - Some Main Rules

# Procurement of consultancy services (main procedure)

- Request for Expressions of Interest (EOI) advertised
  - Brief description of the assignment
  - Qualification requirements
  - Deadline for submission of EOI
- Opening of EOIs by opening committee (POC) not in public
- Evaluation of EOIs by evaluation committee (PEC) and preparation of Short-List

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#### **PPR – Some Main Rules**

# Procurement of consultancy services (main procedure) cont'd

- > Terms of Reference (TOR)
- Request for Proposals (RFP) to short-listed applicants
  - Using STD
  - Containing TOR, contract conditions etc.
- Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal
- Evaluation: Technical Score and Financial Score to be combined (QCBS)
- Negotiations to be held with highest scoring consultant
